Continuing the scenario presented in 848 Rules, the Scoreboard projected before **North** deals 6:

Leader **East** opens Bid, factoring in that **East** also Leads opening Card. **South** bids factoring 2nd, etc.

Note **North**: only one **Yes**, but has the Lead due to one high score.

Also note that while Point Opportunity diminishes towards 4, it does rebound (say 6 Bids x 10...wow).
